## Rules

1. Unless specified otherwise, class divisions include both species and hybrid, any colour, any size.
2. Hybrid means having two or more different parent species.
3. All measurements are across the petals of a flower, natural spread.
4. Only named plants are eligible for rosettes, with the exception of the novice rosette.
5. OCNZ, NZOS or CSA judges may elect to judge nominated plants for awards. This is to be done after class judging is complete.
6. Plants benched or sold on the trading table must be healthy and disease free.
7. The trading table is for financial members who are exhibitors to sell orchid plants, fertilisers, bark and other potting mixes and pots. A commission of 10% (ten percent) is charged on all sales. All proceeds from items sold on the bric-a-brac and jam table will go towards the club.

## Open class schedule

### Oncidium and allied genera

(Eg. Oncidium, Odontoglossum, Cochlioda, Miltonia, Brassia, Tolumnia)

1. Under 40mm
2. 40-80mm
3. Over 80mm

### Masdevallia and allied genera

(Includes Dracula)

4. Hybrid – over 40mm, excluding cordae
5. Hybrid – under 40mm, excluding cordae
6. Species

### Phalaenopsis and allied genera

(Includes Doritis, Doritaenopsis)

7. Standard
8. Miniature multiflorals under 60mm
9. Species

### Paphiopedilum and allied genera

(Includes Phragmipedium)

10. Standard / Complex hybrid
11. Any other hybrid
12. Species

### Cattleya and allied genera

(Eg. Cattleya, Broughtonia, Brassavola, Guaranthe, Laelia, Rhyncholaelia)

13. Under 60mm
14. 60-80mm
15. Over 80mm
16. Multifloral cluster type
17. Epidendrum, Encyclia and Prosthechea

### Dendrobium and allied genera

(Includes Dockrillia)

18. Under 40mm
19. 40-80mm
20. Over 80mm

### Other genera, not listed elsewhere

21. Zygopetalum
22. Cymbidium
23. Large species – over 60mm
24. Small species – under 60mm
25. Large hybrid – over 60mm
26. Small hybrid – under 60mm

### Specimen and baskets

(Any genera, species or hybrid)

27. Baskets up to 800mm x 600mm, 3 flowering plants minimum. Cut flowers allowed.
28. Specimen – over 60mm
29. Specimen – under 60mm

**There will be one rosette for each group of classes and one for the grand champion.**

## Novice class schedule

50. Species – over 60mm
51. Species – under 60mm
52. Hybrid – over 60mm
53. Hybrid – under 60mm

**There will be one rosette awarded for the Best Novice judged from Classes 50--53**
