The plant commentary was conducted by Lee Neale and Grahame Leafberg. The lucky draw from last month was won by Barry Baxter.

### <u>GUEST SPEAKERS</u> - Burt and Evelyn Ong <u>'Passive Hydroponics'(Part 2)</u>

This month Burt and Evelyn showed us how they have incorporated their orchids within their home. A Power Point presentation had us fascinated as to how they achieved this.

By attaching guttering to the wall of the selected room they place their brochure holder in the guttering. Water held at the bottom of these brochure holders is feeding the plant with a wick inserted in the liquid, making sure that the roots are not soaked, just getting small amounts of food and water. The water in these containers must be changed regularly. The laundry and even the bathroom are homes to their experiment.

Care is taken with air circulation using fans.

The outdoor covered patio was treated this winter to a heat board which encouraged all the neighbourhood nasties - rodents cockroaches etc who decided it was a very comfortable area to set up a new home! The heat board was soon removed!

Cork, ponga, coconut fibre, or similar materials, with a small amount of bark and pumice for drainage is used when mounting the orchids.

Burt did remind anyone who might be using brochure holders that they do need to bung the holes at the bottom using aquarium glue only as other glues could be toxic to the plants.
