MESSAGE OF THE MONTH

As I sit here writing the editorial it is raining and cold and miserable and I am wondering how my orchids are feeling.

With our show only a matter of weeks away this sort of weather is not really very welcome. It is a crucial time when watering and I think the best rule is if in doubt don't water as so much damage can be done by watering in adverse conditions. Water sitting on leaves or in the axils can totally ruin your plant and the damp could cause botritis and encourage mould as well. We need your plants and flowers for the show so please be aware of the weather conditions. Leaks in the glasshouse roofing can cause damage, especially if a favourite plant is directly below the leak. Fix the leak or move the plant.

Frost is another problem to overcome. Use frost cloth and keep the fans and heaters going especially if you know that there will be a frost.

Check for bugs and stake spikes ready for the show ED
