

<u>GUEST SPEAKER</u> <u>Leigh Leaity</u>

Leigh gave an interesting talk accompanied by a Power Point presentation on what judges are looking for when judging and awarding plants at our shows.

Display criteria was explained taking note that we should have a good colour scheme, conform to the theme as per the schedule and that a Table Top display meant just that and would be marked down for having plants sitting on the floor.

Also of interest was the explaining of flower shapes and how they were judged.

I am sure we feel more confident now when entering our plants, knowing exactly what the judges are looking for.

Leigh also gave us a great tip on using a coloured clothes peg on the top of your flower stake to prevent damage to eyes while either transporting or just checking out progress of flower spikes in the shade house.

Thank you Leigh for a very enlightening talk.
