GUEST SPEAKERS - Peter and Georgina

Peter and Georgina have been growing orchids indoors in Calgary, Canada for 15 years. They belong to their local orchid club. Travelling to NZ frequently and for long periods of time, they found it unfair to ask friends to look after their plants for such a long period, so they sold them all! They have bought land in Whakatane and now grow their orchids under the trees! They are growing, dendrobs, disa and paphs with carnivorous plants to eat the bugs! All seem to be growing well. We were shown pictures of Canadian native cypripedium 'Montana'- a ground growing orchid which grows quite commonly on the sides of the roads. Snow insulates the bulbs in winter and they flower in the Spring. Squirrels sometimes dig them up for winter feed! Special varieties can be bought for around \$75 per bulb, (rather expensive squirrel food!)

They grew their plants in their basement under lights which were on 16 hrs a day with fans circulating the air. Heating was from the fluorescent and halogen lights. Watering was difficult as rainwater had to used. (Their mains water contains a lot of calcium.) A fogger is also used.

Most hobby orchid growers just have a few orchids growing on their windowsills.

We must give them a medal for their dedication to 'orchid growing the hard way'. We can be thankful that our growing is a breeze compared to theirs! Mary.


