## GROWING PLANTS MY WAY...... DENNIS

Question: Why do I grow orchids?

**Answer:** To grow something different. I want to display my plants and to also propagate. My aim is to grow well.

Be selective. Only grow what you know you can grow well and decide what you cannot (or should not) grow.

Have fun but don't be a slave to your hobby, everyone can learn to be successful.

Observe the leaves, roots and bulbs of your plants.

**Research:** Use our club. Talk to local successful growers near to where you grow your own orchids and be aware of different growing conditions.

Use the internet or OrchidWiz but also remember that the loudest opinion is not always the best opinion!

Don't be afraid to ask why? (like a three year old), ask for an explanation. Then think, 'what if?'

Grow a few plants the same way then compare them against the normal way you grow and only change one thing at a time.

Your goal is what You think you can achieve and what you have learned throughout the experiment. Broaden your knowledge. Observe. Research. Think and experiment - but most of all have fun.

## HOW OUR CLUB OPERATES

#### **Your Executive Committee:**

The executive Committee meets on the 4th Monday of the month at 7pm at the Lincoln Road Bible Chapel on Lincoln Rd, Henderson. Meetings generally take one and a half hours and it is here where planning for the running of the club takes place. There are no meetings held in December and January. We need new members on this committee as they bring fresh and different ideas in many areas and stop us from becoming stale or routine.

## **President:**

This is recognized as a 3 year term. The President attends all executive and show committee meetings and is responsible for the smooth running of the club ensuring that each committee member fulfils their role. The President fronts the club night meeting assisted by various sub-committee members. The President is also seen as the link between the club and the Orchid Council of NZ and other clubs within and outside of Auckland.

#### Vice President:

Back up to the President. Attends the Executive Meeting and it is expected that they will progress to President on completion of the current presidential term.

#### Secretary:

Attends monthly executive meeting and records the minutes of the meeting. Prints these along with an agenda, ready for the next executive meeting. Attends to any correspondence. The secretary is also required to vet the incoming correspondence and present essential information, particularly from the Orchid Council of NZ, to the executive committee.

## **Treasurer:**

Expected to attend executive and show committee meetings as well as club night. Keeps the records of all income and expenditure and attends to banking requirements, presents a monthly financial statement to each executive meeting. Prepares annual records for analysis by the auditor and presents these at the AGM.

#### **Bulletin Editor/Publications Chairperson:**

Produces the monthly newsletter, organizes the printing and posting of same as well as dispatching the email format. The Editor is the lynch pin of the society as she/he keeps us informed and up to date on countless issues. On the monthly club night the editor records all necessary items from the meeting for reporting in the Bulletin and also attends the executive meeting. Throughout the month they are the point of contact for many queries pertaining to the club or its members.

#### **Membership Secretary:**

Collects and collates all the subscriptions from members. Meets and greets newer members on club night and manages the attendance register. Contacts new members for the first three months of membership to remind them of club night. Follows up on potential members following the shows. Attends executive committee meeting.

#### **Program Chairperson:**

Is responsible for the social side of the club and has a team of members to assist in the duties. On Club night ensuring the tea break is managed. At show time the kitchen is manned and provides refreshments for the workers. During the year social events are organized, in particular bus trips or day jaunts. In the case of ill health or bereavements, cards are sent as appropriate. Attends the executive meeting.

#### Librarian:

Maintains the club library. Sets the books out on club night and signs them out to members as well as ensuring books are returned in a timely fashion. Attends the monthly executive meeting.

Extra executive members help with decision making of the club and assist as needed in any area where they are able. Please consider joining the this team of willing workers - put your hand up at the AGM!
