The Guest Speaker was Jason Fischer -Neofinetia.

Dennis introduced Jason. He was born into orchid growning and breeding.

A powerpoint presentation was given on how the Japanese shows are staged, much different than our shows - purely presentation. Pots and how they are mounted are important. Presentation showed the different leaf pattern, leaf shape, axis colour, root system, and flowers. Average day temperatures 23 - 32°, night time low 15 - 21 °. Winter rest is not necessary. Colder = less water. Medium Light. All are potted in NZ Spag Moss before the roots emerge (Sept/Oct) and is replaced every year.


