## **QUESTION TIME**

Q. My Cym seedling looks large enough to flower, but hasn't. Why?

A. The new growth probably came at the wrong time last year.

**Comment:** You should never grow cymbidiums in too much shade-they need lots of light especially in the growing season.

Quote: Yellow leaves- plenty of flowers

Green leaves - plenty of growths and too much nitrogen in autumn.

**Q.** My standard cymbidium is very late in flowering. A. This could all be due to it's breeding or even the seasonal changes. They need a 10° C change in temperature to initiate spikes. This is difficult to achieve in Auckland especially if plants are all cramped in the shade house.

**Q.** I have blotchy leaves on my Den *speciosum?* 

**A.** Cold is a possibility.

**Q.** I want to divide my Masd Susan but it won't stop flowering!

A. Just do it! Cut the flowers off first and if the roots are weak wrap them in spaghnum and wait for the roots to recover.



## **CULTURE** Ken Morse

Ken gave us a brief talk on the not so well known Den Cassiope. (Cassiope is made from 50% nobile and 50% *moniforme*)

This orchid flowers on bare canes from about July until October similar to the way den nobile does.

Ken grows his in No3 bark in plastic pots with very good drainage. Watering is done once a week in winter and every day during summer. Don't dry them off in winter.

They produce kei kei's readily, so there are always new plants to be gained this way.

They are grown cool and will even be happy grown outside in Auckland.

Slugs just love the buds!

ED Ken grows magnificent orchids and now that he has retired will be growing even more prize winners as shown above. He won Grand Champion at our Ribbon Show this year with a lovely Paph.

## PRIZE GIVING


