Lee presented the Power Point program that Dennis had set up for the presentation of prizes showing each plant at the same time as President Roy gave the relevant trophy to each of the trophy winners.

This was a wonderful way of refreshing our memory as to the winning plants.

SHOW COMMITTEE ELECTIONS

Ken Morse spoke of how impressed he was with the venue of the show this year. Parking was not a problem and a show of hands from members agreed with Ken. The show committee will discuss this matter during their meeting.

DEFLASKING - the Neale way....

During the evening Lee showed us her way of de flasking. She had a flask purchased for the club of Roy Tokunaga's mini cattleyas of which she had removed the lid 24 hours previously.

Water which had just the chill taken off was put into the flask and gently shaken to loosen the agar off the roots of the plants. They were then rinsed in fresh water and each plant was inspected and any dead foliage or roots were removed with tweezers before drying on folded newspaper for at least ½ an hour. This enables the plants to 'firm up'.

Bark used in the potting mix had been soaked for 2 days and the dregs scooped off, leaving the quality No 2 bark ready to be used.

The potting medium was made up of: 6 parts No2 bark, 1 part pumice, 1 part palm fibre.(bricks of this available at plant centres).

Plant in trays and don't water for 24 hours. Fertilise with *phostrogen* in a very weak solution and water with this each day if needed.

Lee considers day 10 as the 'critical day'-they either live or die!

After a month she increases the fertiliser strength and as they grow they are 'potted on'. A heat board offers some comfort during colder weather.

Labeling of each plant is a must.

Thanks Lee for a very down to earth approach. I am sure most of us are terrified of attempting deflasking, but you made it look so easy! Maybe a few more members will now have a go and enjoy the pleasure of watching their 'babies' progress and the expectation of maybe a future Grand Champion.
