Those members with a # beside their plant name, please correct your label. Names written in *italics* depicts it is a *species*.

This may explain a few things......

Vuylstekeara (**Vuyl**) = Cochlioda x Miltonia x Odontoglossum.

Odontioda (**Oda**) = Cochlioda x Odontoglossum.

Vuyl \mathbf{x} **Oda** = Vuyl as it is comprised of the same three species.

Zygopabstia (**Zba**)= Pabistia x Zygopetalum.

Beallara = Brassia x Cochlioda x Miltonia x Odontoglossum

Hope this helps!
